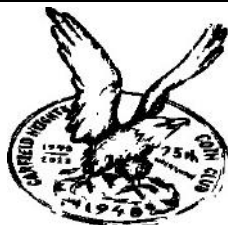

Gary and Fletcher did the auction once again and Fletcher did a great job. We had a very strong sales month and a had a near all-time auction sales high. We had some real surprises, even with our supplies and books. Total auction sales were \$5,099.00, \$1,067.50 more than last month's \$4,031.50. The average lot sale was \$57.29, \$8.92 less than last month's \$66.22. The median value was \$32.00, \$2.00 less than last month's \$34.00. There were 23 passed lots vs. last month's 23.
