Lou did a presentation on rare, valuable State Quarters existing right under our noses. Selected coins were listed on a prepared sheet, showing value, grade and PCGS populations. Gary and Fletcher did the auction once again and Fletcher did a great job. We had another strong sales month and a had a near all-time auction sales high. Biodding was spirited. Total auction sales were \$4,031.50, \$1,464.50 less than last month's \$5,496. The average lot sale was \$43.82, \$22.40 less than last month's \$66.22. The median value was \$29.50, \$4.50 less than last month's \$34.00. There were 23 passed lots vs. last month's 38. We also had one buyback of a coin, when a consignor saw the Greysheet Wholesale price move \$5 higher since mid-January and panicked. We had a nice high sell-through rate of 82.2% of the total lots. Once again, Joe Sangrik continued his streak of not buying anything.
